### BIRCH MEMORIAL CLOCK TOWER

Birch Memorial Clock Tower is a magnificent monument built in 1909. It was built in the memory of James Birch who was the first British resident of Perak, and its biggest attraction is the 1.95m diameter bell. A huge horizontal band of sculpture, featuring Moses, Buddha, Shakespeare and Charles Darwin is present here. There are tourists crowding this place during maximum hours. 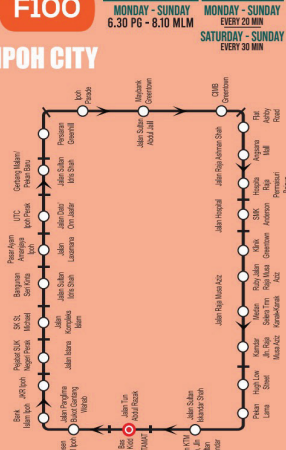

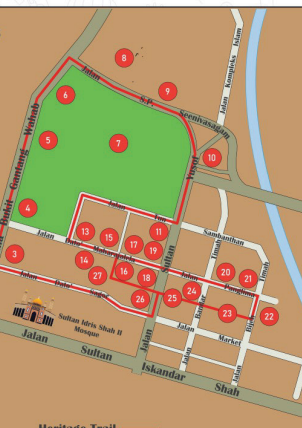

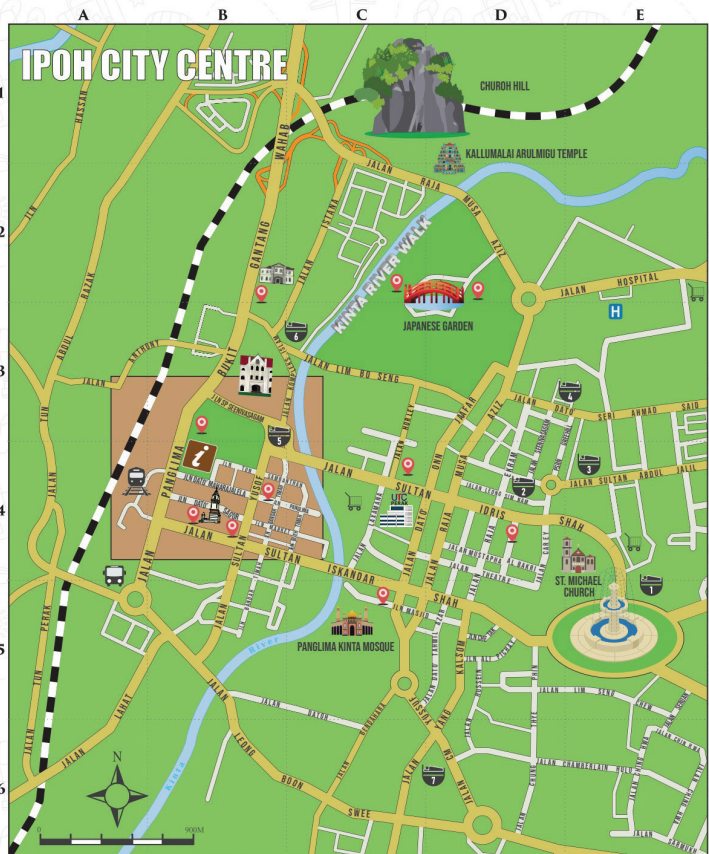
